### **Traffic Safety:**

Please see attached news release regarding the 2013 traffic fatalities: Although the state has experienced significant decreases in traffic crashes over the past decade, from 391,486 in 2003 to 289,061 in 2013, fatalities increased 2 percent from 936 in 2012 to 951. **The biggest jumps occurred in drug-involved fatalities which increased 22 percent from 135 in 2012 to 165 in 2013**
