- SB247 – extending alcohol sales to 4 a.m. Coordinator reported that there has been no change on the status of this bill.
- HB4891 – earmarking money for prevention and treatment. Coordinator reported that there has been no change on the status of this bill.
- MLCC Declaratory Ruling regarding ½ mile rule. This declaratory ruling could have had large implications. MLCC upheld the ½ mile rule when they issued their Declaratory Ruling in December 2013.
- S.1900 – [Trans-Pacific Partnership Trade Agreement](#) – Alcohol Justice Action Alert. Coordinator reported that it's his understanding that this has not been a transparent process and that some public health advocates believe these trade agreements can trump local alcohol policies and laws.
