**The Community Preventive Services Task Force (Task Force) recommends publicized sobriety checkpoint programs as an effective intervention to reduce alcohol-impaired driving.** This recommendation is based on a systematic review of all available studies that was conducted—with oversight from the Task Force—by scientists and subject matter experts from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in collaboration with a wide range of government, academic, policy, and practice-based partners.
