- **SAMHSA: New Data in CBHSQ Reports**
  - **Emergency Department Data:** New research is available about emergency department visits involving underage alcohol misuse from 2010 to 2013. The CBHSQ Report explains that nearly 40 percent of substance-related emergency department (ED) visits made by patients aged 12 to 20 involved alcohol misuse.
