II. Approval of meeting minutes from August 22, 2017.

III. Committee Reports & Recommendations

- a. Shoalition Showcase Planning – Next meeting is November 20 @ 3:00 p.m. People are encouraged to participate. Met last Monday. Lisa Coleman has taken a new job with the State of Michigan and may have to step down as Chair.
- b. Executive – conference call October 16.
- c. MCRUD Birthday Celebration – Date: July 2018? MCRUD turns 22 this year! E.J. reported. Ken and E.J. have not met yet. Looking at July 24.

IV. Local/State/National Issues or News

- a. MLCC – December 6 MLCC Hearing; Mike reported that MLCC has taken action to rescind the Half Mile Rule. People in opposition to this action are concerned that this could potentially increase outlet density; Matt reported that he may be able to attend the hearing on December 6 and Mike and Janine reported that they are planning on attending the hearing.
- b. MI Legislature – see attachment “Pending Bills 2017-2018, updated 10.13.17. Mike briefly reported on the following bills:
 - i. SB501 and HB 4504 both are designed to codify the half mile rule.
 - ii. HB4547 and HB4548 – both are designed to keep Michigan’s BAC level at .08.
 - iii. SB372 is designed to repeal the keg tagging law.
 - iv. HB5085 would earmark funding for SUD services.
- c. National – Mike reported that there is still a bill to lower alcohol taxes and that periodically he will see updates that more co-sponsors have been added.
- d. MI Coalition to Raise the Beer Tax – Next meeting is Monday, November 27 at 10:00 a.m. Information was presented to MI Leg Black Caucus in September.

E.J. McAndrew – opioids are the topic of the day and EJ raised the question of how do we get our voice heard around underage drinking? A conference is scheduled for March on opioids.

Teresa Sander – nothing to report at this time.

Danyelle – working a lot on the heroin issue. Danyelle attended the community trials training and is offering TIPS training twice a month.

Kelsey – nothing to report at this time.

Michele – we just completed the “Every 15 Minutes” program. First time it was done in Delta County. Received very good feedback about this two day event.

Matthew – our youth coalition is getting some traction in the community and have started a pledge campaign to not drink; Downriver youth are working on a psa to be aired in the schools. Last week, Debbie Dingell and Joe Kennedy came to the area to speak about the opioid issue.

Amy – doing some work with the jail and detention center. She teaches “Safety” which is an evidence based program. A poster contest was held and it went well. Amy reported that the new initiative with the jail is a very positive thing.

Patrick – no major updates from the state. Some information on the ½ mile rule has been sent up the chain. Patrick reported that there is evidence toward limiting outlet density. Patrick continues to update their website and fact sheets.

Janine – an Opiate conference on the 10.13.17. About 160 people attended. Focused a lot of SBIRT. Peer 360 Recovery Alliance participated. Doing a lot of stuff with the schools in terms of tobacco, focusing on e-cigarettes and has been asked to do an e-cigarette presentation for Mid-State. CAPT is planning some events for December. “TIE one On” with local dealership. Will be participating in a St. Patrick’s Day parade in March.

Karra Thomas – there are some Greater Detroit Area Health Council events coming up. One is entitled “Medical Marijuana vs. Opioids.”
